During installation of a new app, the installer creates a number of container directories for the app inside the sandbox directory. In those cases, the system frameworks use helper apps to handle any file-related operations needed to read from or modify the appropriate data stores. One exception to this rule is when an app uses public system interfaces to access things such as the users contacts or music. The data container directory is further divided into a number of subdirectories that the app can use to sort and organize its data. Writing to this directory changes the signature and prevents your app from launching. APFS is the default file system in macOS, iOS, watchOS, and tvOS APFS replaces HFS as the default file system for iOS 10. Precisely where you put files depends on the platform, but the overarching goal is to make sure that the users files remain easily discoverable and that the files your code uses internally are kept out of the users way. This table also describes any additional access restrictions for each subdirectory and points out whether the directories contents are backed up by iTunes and iCloud. Therefore, the file system is one of the fundamental resources used by all processes. The bundle container directory holds the apps bundle, whereas the data container directory holds data for both the app and the user.
